



Polla Parlay Official Rules

Lígalo Online — Polla Parlay

MULTIPLICA TU PASIÓN

1. Overview

Polla Parlay is a collective pool game in a sports parlay format. Participants make a fixed number of picks (configured by administration, typically 5 picks) on sporting events from various leagues (MLB, NBA, NFL, Soccer, etc.). Each pick can be a Moneyline, Spread, or Totals (Over/Under) selection.

Points are calculated by summing the decimal odds of each correct pick. The player with the highest score wins the main prize from the collective pool.

- Pool format: all participants contribute to the prize pool with their entry fee.
- Multi-sport: a single polla can include events from multiple leagues.
- Round system: each group of events with the same start time constitutes a round.
- Automatic settlement: the system calculates scores and distributes prizes automatically once all events have concluded.

2. How to Participate

- Access the Polla Parlay section from the Sports menu or the featured leagues banner.
- Select the active polla (there may be pollas from different leagues open simultaneously).
- Make your picks. The required number is displayed on screen (e.g., "Choose your 5 picks").
- For each event, choose one option: Moneyline (ML), Spread, or Total (Over/Under). You cannot select more than one option from the same event.
- Confirm and seal your ticket by paying the entry amount.
- You may seal multiple tickets in the same polla with different combinations.

3. Selection Types

Each selection corresponds to a wager on a specific sporting event:

- Moneyline (ML): Select which team will win the game. Odds are displayed in American format (e.g., -150, +130).
- Spread: Select a team with a point/run advantage or disadvantage. The team must cover the spread for the pick to be correct.
- Totals (Over/Under): Select whether the combined total of points/runs/goals will be over or under the set line.

Restriction: You cannot select both Moneyline and Run Line (Spread) from the same event on the same ticket.

4. Scoring System

Each ticket's score is calculated based on the decimal odds of correct picks:

- For each correct pick, the decimal odds of that selection at the time of polla closure are added to your score.
- For each incorrect pick, 0 points are added.
- 5/5 Bonus: If you get all picks correct on your ticket, an additional bonus is applied to your total score (configured by administration).

Push Rule (no push in Polla Parlay):

- In Polla Parlay there is no push. If the result lands exactly on the line, the pick is considered a loss and generates 0 points.
- Totals (Over/Under): If the line is set at 8 and the combined total of the game is exactly 8, the pick is considered incorrect (0 points). This applies to both Over and Under selections.
- Spread: If the selected team covers the spread by exactly the line amount (no margin), the pick is also considered a loss (0 points).

Example: If you picked ML Yankees at 1.65 decimal odds and it was correct, 1.65 points are added. If you picked Over 8 runs and the game total was exactly 8, 0 points are added (no push).

5. Prize Structure

The total pool is distributed among the top-ranked participants by score:

- 1st place: 75% of the total pool.
- 2nd place: 20% of the total pool.
- 3rd place: 5% of the total pool.
- 4th place: Free entry to the next available polla.

In case of a tie in points between two or more participants, the prizes for the tied positions are combined and divided equally among them.

Administration may adjust the percentages and number of prize positions based on the number of participants.

6. Round System

The Polla Parlay operates with a round system based on event start times:

- Round 1: Before the first group of events begins. This round has the initial odds.
- Round 2 onward: Each time a group of events (with the same start time) begins, the next round starts.
- Odds are updated according to the current round — tickets sealed in later rounds use the odds in effect at the time of polla closure.
- The polla closes automatically when fewer than 3 events remain unstarted.

Each round is identified with a different color in the interface for easy visualization.

7. Closure and Settlement

- The polla closes automatically when fewer than 3 events are yet to begin.
- Upon closure, a snapshot of the current odds is taken for each selection.
- Scores are updated progressively as events conclude.
- Once all events have finished, the system automatically calculates the final ranking, prizes, and credits the winning amounts to the winners' accounts.
- Results and the final ranking are published in the Polla Parlay Listing section and in the Session Information.

8. Cancellations and Suspended Events

Event cancelled or postponed BEFORE the selection:

- If an event is cancelled or postponed before the user has sealed their ticket, the event simply will not appear available in the selection grid.

Event postponed or suspended AFTER the selection:

- If an event is postponed or suspended after the user has already sealed their ticket with that event included, the corresponding pick is voided and removed from the ticket.
- The ticket is automatically recalculated with the remaining picks. The effective number of picks on the ticket is reduced accordingly.
- If the reduction in picks leaves the ticket with fewer picks than the minimum required, the ticket remains valid with the remaining picks and is evaluated normally.
- The perfect pick bonus (e.g., 5/5) is adjusted to the new total of valid picks on the ticket.

Full polla cancellation:

- If the entire polla is cancelled by administration, all entry amounts are refunded in full to each participant's account balance.

9. Multi-Currency

- The entry amount is expressed in US dollars (USD) as the base currency.
- Multiple currencies are accepted: VES, COP, DOP, EUR, with automatic conversion.
- The exchange rate is locked at the time of ticket sealing.
- Prizes are credited in the user's preferred currency at the exchange rate in effect at the time of settlement.

10. Loyalty Program (Ligalo Points)

- All Polla Parlay entries earn Ligalo Points (LP).
- 1 LP is awarded per \$1 USD of entry amount.
- LP are accumulated on both wins and losses.
- LP contribute to your VIP level and can be redeemed according to the Loyalty Program rules.

11. General Rules

- All amounts are handled in US dollars (USD) as the base currency. Multiple currencies (VES, COP, DOP, EUR) are accepted with automatic conversion.
- Multiple accounts are not allowed. The platform reserves the right to cancel suspicious entries.
- Persons under 18 years of age are not authorized to participate in real-money games.
- Lígalo Online reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. Changes will be communicated to users.
- In the event of any dispute, the decision of Lígalo Internacional administration is final.
